

Eau Claire Conservation Club Project Update Tuesday, 'September 25, 2018

The ECLCC partnered with the Red Cliff Band of Lake Superior Chippewa to scatter plant almost 6,000 walleye in the Middle Eau Claire Lake. Club members provided pontoon boats and manpower to help transfer the extended-growth fish, average length 6.52", from the tanker truck to the tubs and coolers on the boats. The fish were delivered by tribal members Tuesday afternoon.





Four pontoons lined up at the Middle landing with large tanks and coolers filled with lake water.

The fish were transferred from the tanker to the tubs by net, and then sent out into the deepest areas of the lake for release.



All agreed that the operation was a success and look forward to future joint stocking of the lake.
