

TOWN OF BARNES ROADS AND RIGHT OF WAY COMMITTEE
May 18, 2015

Meeting called to order at 1:00 PM

Present were Bob Lang, Dan Stein, Greg Martin, Tom Emerson, and Don Dealing. Also present were Tom Krob and Jim Johnson.

Lang/Martin Minutes from May 4 and May 6 approved subject to spelling correction. Passes.

Regarding the former Frazier property on Lake Road, Tom Krob has contacted Bob Friel regarding the curve at his property and he is very supportive of reducing the radius of the curve (making the road straighter.) Dan will contact the Morgan firm regarding this.

Regarding the area in front of the BAHA storage building, Bob Lang will contact the property owner regarding the back slope issue and how to resolve it.

Discussion regarding the speed limit on Pease Road. Bob Lang will contact the County Highway Dept. and request them: to examine Pease Road to determine whether the speed limit on the road should be lowered; to consider making Pease Road a County Road; and to ask for an opinion regarding the posting of advisory signage on the road.

Discussion regarding existing road conditions and needed road repairs. Bob has budgeted two weeks for a man and equipment to repair, gravel and compact shoulders on town roads as needed. He also reviewed a tentative list of projects to be done by the town crew.

Motion by Dealing/Stein to recommend to the Town Board that Bob Lang be made an alternate member of this committee and designate a new regular voting member. This would mean there would be five voting members along with an alternate non-voting member at all meetings, and in the absence of any voting member Bob would become a voting member. All members would keep current on RROW issues. Passed.

Tom Krob left the meeting at 2:05 PM and Jim Johnson left at 2:45 PM.

The committee made a site visit to the property of Cecil Hehl regarding complaints from him. Mr. Hehl was present and he stated he had put new gravel on his driveway and had no further requests regarding the roads in front of his residence or the other property he has a trailer on.

Next meeting is scheduled for July 13, 1:00 PM at the town office.
